Period of service: As indicated above.



Reason: For exceptionally meritorious service. During the period 8 February 2005 to 5 November 2005, the 376th Personnel Service Battalion and its subordinate units displayed exceptionally meritorious service in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom.
