Award: Meritorious Unit Commendation

Period of service: 1 April 2012 to 10 December 2012

Authority: AR 600-8-22, paragraph 7-15

Reason: For exceptionally meritorious service. During the period 1 April 2012 to 10 December 2012, the Headquarters, 3d Brigade Combat Team, 4th Infantry Division and the cited units deployed to Regional Command-South in Southern Afghanistan to conduct combat and advisory operations in support of Afghan National Security Forces. The cited units were responsible for enabling Afghan National Security Forces to improve their operational effectiveness, expand security throughout the region and assist the Afghan National Security Forces in assuming the security lead in Southern Afghanistan. The efforts of the cited units have been an absolute "Game Changer" for the overall Afghan Campaign Plan. 

It is not the responsibility of HRC to replace streamers that are lost or damaged.
