Constituted 25 February 1943 in the Army of the United States as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 2d Battalion, 522d Quartermaster Truck Regiment

Activated 15 April 1943 at Fort Dix, New Jersey

Reorganized and redesignated 20 November 1943 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 106th Quartermaster Battalion, Mobile

Inactivated 22 February 1946 in Germany

Converted and redesignated 1 August 1946 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 106th Transportation Corps Truck Battalion

Redesignated 1 February 1955 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 106th Transportation Battalion, and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 18 March 1955 in France

Reorganized and redesignated 19 June 1959 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 106th Transportation Battalion

Inactivated 15 September 1993 in Germany

Activated 17 October 1998 at Fort Campbell, Kentucky
