## *Lineage and Honors*

### **HEADQUARTERS AND HEADQUARTERS DETACHMENT 821ST TRANSPORTATION BATTALION**

Constituted 23 September 1943 in the Army of the United States as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 186th Quartermaster Battalion, Mobile

Activated 29 March 1944 at Camp Livingston, Louisiana

Converted and redesignated 1 August 1946 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 186th Transportation Corps Truck Battalion

Inactivated 30 May 1947 in the Philippines

Redesignated 21 June 1948 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 821st Transportation Truck Battalion, and allotted to the Organized Reserve Corps

Activated 7 July 1948 at Topeka, Kansas

Reorganized and redesignated 24 October 1949 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 821st Transportation Truck Battalion

(Organized Reserve Corps redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Reorganized and redesignated 1 November 1952 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 821st Transportation Battalion

Reorganized and redesignated 1 September 1959 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 821st Transportation Battalion

Ordered into active military service 16 December 2003 at Topeka, Kansas; released from active military service 12 June 2005 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 4 September 2011 at Topeka, Kansas; released from active military service 7 October 2012 and reverted to reserve status
