**HEADQUARTERS AND HEADQUARTERS DETACHMENT
470th TRANSPORTATION BATTALION**

Constituted 9 December 1942 in the Army of the United States as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 1st Battalion, 470th Quartermaster Truck Regiment

Activated 30 December 1942 at Camp McCain, Mississippi

Reorganized and redesignated 30 November 1943 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 470th Quartermaster Battalion, Mobile

Inactivated 12 November 1945 in France

Converted and redesignated 1 August 1946 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 470th Transportation Corps Truck Battalion

Redesignated 15 February 1949 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 470th Transportation Truck Battalion and allotted to the Organized Reserve Corps

Activated 10 March 1949 at Xenia, Ohio

Reorganized and redesignated 23 February 1950 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 470th Transportation Truck Battalion

Inactivated 19 October 1950 at Xenia, Ohio

(Organized Reserve Corps redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Redesignated 27 July 1955 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 470th Transportation Battalion

Activated 1 July 1955 at Peoria, Illinois

Inactivated 16 December 1980 at Peoria, Illinois

Activated 16 September 2011 at Arlington Heights, Illinois

Location changed 8 December 2011 to Elwood, Illinois

Ordered into active military service 13 December 2013 at Elwood, Illinois; released from active military service 31 December 2014 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 7 November 2019 at Elwood, Illinois; released from active military service 10 December 2020 and reverted to reserve status


