Constituted 8 December 1967 in the Regular Army as Company C, 123d Aviation Battalion, and activated in Vietnam as an element of the 23d Infantry Division

Inactivated 7 November 1971 in Vietnam and relieved from assignment to the 23d Infantry Division

Activated 17 December 1985 at Fort Campbell, Kentucky, as an element of the 101st Airborne Division

Reorganized and redesignated 16 September 1987 as Company C, 123d Aviation, relieved from assignment to the 101st Airborne Division, and assigned to the 7th infantry Division

Reorganized and redesignated 16 October 1988 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 3d Battalion, 123d Aviation (organic elements concurrently constituted and activated)

Battalion inactivated 15 September 1993 at Fort Ord, California, and relieved from assignment to the 7th Infantry Division

Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 3d Battalion, 123d Aviation, redesignated 16 October 1997 as Company C, 123d Aviation, and activated at Fort Wainwright, Alaska
