HEADQUARTERS 402d FIELD ARTILLERY BRIGADE

Constituted 25 January 1943 in the Army of the United States as Headquarters and Headquarters Battery, 402d Field Artillery Group

Activated 15 March 1943 at Camp Butner, North Carolina

Inactivated 26 October 1945 at Camp Kilmer, New Jersey

Allotted 16 October 1946 to the Organized Reserves

Activated 3 December 1946 at Tulsa, Oklahoma

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Inactivated 22 November 1950 at Tulsa, Oklahoma

Redesignated 16 March 1985 as Headquarters and Headquarters Battery, 402d Brigade (Training) and activated at Lawton, Oklahoma

Inactivated 16 October 1996 at Lawton, Oklahoma

Withdrawn 1 December 2006 from the Army Reserve and allotted to the Regular Army; concurrently redesignated as Headquarters and Headquarters Battery, 402d Field Artillery Brigade, and Headquarters activated at Travis Air Force Base, California
