Constituted 1 May 1936 in the Regular Army as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 95th Quartermaster Battalion (Bakery)

Activated 6 April 1942 at Fort Meade, Maryland, as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 95th Quartermaster Bakery Battalion

Reorganized and redesignated 1 October 1943 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 95th Quartermaster Battalion

Reorganized and redesignated 22 May 1946 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 95th Quartermaster Battalion, Mobile

Converted, reorganized, and redesignated 1 August 1946 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 95th Transportation Corps Truck Battalion

Converted, reorganized, and redesignated 1 February 1947 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 95th Quartermaster Battalion

Inactivated 20 March 1948 in Germany

Reorganized and redesignated 9 February 1950 as Headquarters, 95th Quartermaster Service Battalion

Activated 16 April 1950 at Marburg, Germany

Reorganized and redesignated 20 October 1951 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 95th Quartermaster Battalion

Converted, reorganized, and redesignated between 4 August 1965 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 95th Supply and Service Battalion

Inactivated 21 December 1972 in Germany

Activated 16 September 2022 at Baumholder, Germany


