Activated 25 April 1942 at Fort D. A. Russell, Texas

Reorganized and redesignated 14 February 1944 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 81st Chemical Battalion, Motorized

Redesignated 22 February 1945 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 81st Chemical Mortar Battalion

Inactivated 7 November 1945 at Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri

Redesignated 17 April 1951 as Headquarters, 81st Chemical Group, and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 8 May 1951 at Fort Bragg, North Carolina

Reorganized and redesignated 12 February 1952 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 81st Chemical Group

Reorganized and redesignated 1 December 1953 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 81st Chemical Group

Inactivated 12 September 1962 at Fort Bragg, North Carolina
