Constituted 8 March 1944 in the Army of the United States as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 228th Quartermaster Battalion

Activated 25 March 1944 at Camp Breckinridge, Kentucky

Inactivated 25 January 1946 in the Philippine Islands

Redesignated 7 March 1947 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 383d Quartermaster Battalion, and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 24 March 1947 at Dallas, Texas

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; on 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Inactivated 31 October 1950 at Dallas, Texas

Activated 1 December 1955 at Dallas, Texas

Inactivated 1 April 1959 at Dallas, Texas

Activated 1 March 1963 at El Paso, Texas

Reorganized and redesignated 30 December 1967 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 383d Quartermaster Battalion

Ordered into active military service 27 September 1990 at El Paso, Texas; released 3 June 1991 from active military service and reverted to reserve status
