Constituted 31 January 1966 in the Army Reserve as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 354th Civil Affairs Area, and activated at Riverdale, Maryland

Reorganized and redesignated 1 June 1975 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 354th Civil Affairs Brigade

Detachment ordered into active military service 11 December 1990 at Riverdale, Maryland; remainder of unit ordered into active military service 3 January 1991 at Riverdale, Maryland; Detachment released from active military service 14 April 1991 and reverted to reserve status; remainder of unit released from active military service 24 June 1991 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 7 March 2003 at Riverdale, Maryland; released from active military service 24 May 2004 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 7 November 2009 at Riverdale, Maryland; released from active military service 11 December 2010 and reverted to reserve status
