HEADQUARTERS AND HEADQUARTERS DETACHMENT 372d QUARTERMASTER BATTALION

Constituted 15 June 1944 in the Army of the United States as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 533d Quartermaster Group

Activated 18 June 1944 in England

Inactivated 25 June 1946 in France

Redesignated 12 May 1947 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 372d Quartermaster Battalion, and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 15 June 1947 at Salt Lake City, Utah

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Inactivated 1 June 1959 at Salt Lake City, Utah

(Companies A and B, 372d Quartermaster Battalion, constituted 5 November 1962 and allotted to the Army Reserve)

Battalion activated 15 March 1963 at Pocatello, Idaho

Inactivated 29 February 1968 at Pocatello, Idaho


