## Lineage and Honors

### HEADQUARTERS 85th DIVISION (EXERCISE) (CUSTER)

Constituted 5 August 1917 in the National Army as Headquarters, 85th Division

Organized 25 August 1917 at Camp Custer, Michigan

Demobilized 18 April 1919 at Camp Custer, Michigan

Reconstituted 24 June 1921 in the Organized Reserves as Headquarters, 85th Division

Organized 10 September 1921 at Detroit, Michigan

Redesignated 31 March 1942 as Division Headquarters, 85th Division

Ordered into active military service 15 May 1942 and reorganized at Camp Shelby, Mississippi

Redesignated 1 August 1942 as Headquarters, 85th Infantry Division

Disbanded 25 August 1945 at Camp Patrick Henry, Virginia

Reconstituted 6 November 1946 in the Organized Reserves as Headquarters, 85th Infantry Division

Activated 19 February 1947 at Litchfield, Illinois

Location changed 10 July 1947 to Springfield, Illinois

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Reorganized and redesignated 1 June 1959 as Headquarters and Headquarters  
Company, 85th Division (Training)


