### **HEADQUARTERS AND HEADQUARTERS DETACHMENT 446TH TRANSPORTATION BATTALION**

Constituted 10 November 1942 in the Army of the United States as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 2d Battalion, 467th Quartermaster Truck Regiment

Activated 10 December 1942 at Fort Custer, Michigan

Reorganized and redesignated 16 December 1943 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 77th Quartermaster Battalion, Mobile

Inactivated 8 October 1945 at Camp Shanks, New York

Converted and redesignated 1 August 1946 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 77th Transportation Corps Truck Battalion

Redesignated 6 May 1947 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 309th Transportation Service Group and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 20 May 1947 at Louisville, Kentucky

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Reorganized and redesignated 25 May 1950 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 446th Transportation Truck Battalion

Inactivated 15 May 1952 at Louisville, Kentucky

Redesignated 16 March 1964 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 446th Transportation Battalion


