Activated 27 December 1943 at Camp Hood, Texas

Reorganized and redesignated 20 May 1946 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 52d Ordnance Service Group

Reorganized and redesignated 20 December 1946 as the 52d Ordnance Composite Group

Inactivated 30 June 1948 at Hirsching, Austria

Redesignated 8 January 1952 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 52d Ordnance Group and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 28 January 1952 at Fort Bragg, North Carolina

Inactivated 16 May 1955 at Fort Bragg, North Carolina

Activated 2 December 1965 at Fort Bragg, North Carolina

Inactivated 20 October 1967 at Saigon, Vietnam

Redesignated 1 October 1993 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 52d Ordnance Group, and activated at Fort Gillem, Georgia
