HEADQUARTERS AND HEADQUARTERS DETACHMENT 504th MILITARY POLICE BATTALION (DRAGON FIGHTERS)

Constituted 29 July 1921 in the Organized Reserves as the 304th Military Police Battalion

Organized in April 1922 in Tennessee

Inactivated 1 January 1938 in Tennessee; concurrently withdrawn from the Organized Reserves and allotted to the Regular Army

Redesignated 1 June 1940 as the 504th Military Police Battalion

Activated 15 May 1941 at Fort Sam Houston, Texas

(Company D inactivated 20 June 1942 at Fort Sam Houston, Texas)

Inactivated 20 January 1947 in Germany

Activated 2 October 1950 at Camp Gordon, Georgia

(Companies, A, B, and C inactivated 31 July 1972 at the Presidio of San Francisco, California)
