Inactivated 3 April 1950 at Indianapolis, Indiana

(Organized Reserve Corps redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Redesignated 20 April 1953 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 180th Medical Battalion

Activated 16 September 1995 at Columbus, Ohio
