Constituted 23 February 1943 in the Army of the United States as Headquarters, 2d Medical Department Concentration Center

Activated 25 June 1943 at Carlisle Barracks, Pennsylvania

Reorganized and redesignated 30 December 1944 as Headquarters, 31st Hospital Center

Reorganized and redesignated 1 May 1945 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 31st Hospital Center

Inactivated 10 April 1946 in the Philippines

Redesignated 5 June 1947 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 303d Hospital Center, and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 19 June 1947 at Philadelphia, Pennsylvania

(Organized Reserves redesignated 28 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Reorganized and redesignated 10 September 1949 as Headquarters, 303d Hospital Center

Redesignated 9 May 1953 as Headquarters, 31st Hospital Center

Reorganized and redesignated 1 April 1955 as the 31st Medical Detachment

Reorganized and redesignated 8 November 1955 as the 31st Headquarters, Hospital Center

Reorganized and redesignated 1 September 1960 as the Headquarters, 31st Hospital Center

Inactivated 1 November 1971 at Folson, Pennsylvania
