HEADQUARTERS AND HEADQUARTERS DETACHMENT 436th TRANSPORTATION BATTALION

Constituted 18 March 1949 in the Organized Reserve Corps as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 436th Transportation Truck Battalion

Activated 25 March 1949 at Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania

Location changed 30 September 1949 to Butler, Pennsylvania

Reorganized and redesignated 5 September 1950 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 436th Transportation Truck Battalion

(Organized Reserve Corps redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Reorganized and redesignated 2 June 1953 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 436th Transportation Battalion

Reorganized and redesignated 3 August 1959 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 436th Transportation Battalion

Ordered into active military service 15 October 1961 at Butler, Pennsylvania; released from active military service 10 August 1962 and reverted to reserve status

Inactivated 31 January 1968 at Butler, Pennsylvania

Activated 2 September 1996 on Staten Island, New York

Ordered into active military service 13 August 2004 at Staten Island, New York; released from active military service 8 February 2006 and reverted to reserve status


