HEADQUARTERS AND HEADQUARTERS BATTERY 35th AIR DEFENSE ARTILLERY BRIGADE

Constituted 1 June 1918 in the National Army as Headquarters, 35th Artillery Brigade, Coast Artillery Corps, and organized at Fort Hunt, Virginia

Demobilized 11 March 1919 at Fort Totten, New York

Reconstituted 1 October 1933 in the Regular Army as Headquarters and Headquarters Battery, 35th Coast Artillery Brigade

Activated 20 November 1942 at Camp Stewart, Georgia

Redesignated 14 June 1944 as Headquarters and Headquarters Battery, 35th Antiaircraft Artillery Brigade

Inactivated 26 October 1945 at Camp Kilmer, New Jersey

Activated 1 November 1948 at Fort Bliss, Texas

Redesignated 20 March 1958 as Headquarters and Headquarters Battery, 35th Artillery Brigade

Redesignated 15 March 1972 as Headquarters and Headquarters Battery, 35th Air Defense Artillery Brigade

Inactivated 4 June 1973 at Fort George G. Meade, Maryland

Activated 1 June 1985 at Fort Lewis, Washington
