Constituted 23 November 1944 in the Army of the United States as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 526th Port Battalion, Transportation Corps

Activated 4 December 1944 at Camp Gordon Johnston, Florida

Inactivated 20 May 1946 on Okinawa

Redesignated 16 October 1947 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 348th Transportation Port Battalion and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 3 November 1947 at Houston, Texas

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Reorganized and redesignated 1 November 1950 as Headquarters, Headquarters and Service Company, 348th Transportation Port Battalion

Reorganized and redesignated 8 April 1955 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 348th Transportation Battalion
