HEADQUARTERS AND HEADQUARTERS DETACHMENT 346th TRANSPORTATION BATTALION

Constituted 13 July 1944 in the Army of the United States as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 587th Quartermaster Battalion, Mobile

Activated 29 July 1944 in England

Inactivated 19 October 1945 at Camp Gruber, Oklahoma

Converted and redesignated 1 August 1946 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 587th Transportation Corps Truck Battalion

Redesignated 27 January 1948 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 346th Transportation Truck Battalion, and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 12 February 1948 at San Juan, Puerto Rico

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Reorganized and redesignated 18 May 1950 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 346th Transportation Truck Battalion

Reorganized and redesignated 12 February 1953 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 346th Transportation Battalion

Inactivated 26 November 1954 at San Juan, Puerto Rico

HEADQUARTERS AND HEADQUARTERS DETACHMENT 346th TRANSPORTATION BATTALION

Activated 18 March 1956 at San Juan, Puerto Rico

Reorganized and redesignated 1 October 1959 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 346th Transportation Battalion

Location changed 1 November 1969 to Puerto Nuevo, Puerto Rico; on 17 March 1974 to Bayamon, Puerto Rico; on 30 January 1994 to Ceiba, Puerto Rico

Ordered into active military service 7 February 2003 at Ceiba, Puerto Rico; released from active military service 6 February 2004 and reverted to reserve status


