Constituted 25 February 1943 in the Army of the United States as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 336th Ordnance Battalion

Activated 15 October 1943 at Fort Jackson, South Carolina

Inactivated 20 November 1945 at Camp Campbell, Kentucky

Allotted 7 February 1947 to the Organized Reserves

Activated 19 February 1947 at El Paso, Texas

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Inactivated 25 July 1950 at El Paso, Texas

Activated 1 May 1964 at Little Rock, Arkansas

Reorganized and redesignated 1 November 1965 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 336th Ordnance Battalion

Ordered into active military service 13 May 1968 at Little Rock, Arkansas; released from active military service 15 August 1969 and reverted to reserve status

Location changed 1 March 1989 to North Little Rock, Arkansas

Inactivated 15 September 1989 at North Little Rock, Arkansas

Redesignated 16 September 2006 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 336th Support Battalion, and activated at Phoenix, Arizona
