Reorganized and redesignated 27 August 1943 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 4th Quartermaster Battalion, Mobile

Converted and redesignated 1 August 1946 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 4th Transportation Corps Truck Battalion

Inactivated 15 March 1947 in Germany

Redesignated 21 April 1949 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 4th Transportation Truck Battalion

Activated 1 June 1949 on Okinawa

Inactivated 1 July 1950 on Okinawa

Redesignated 20 November 1950 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 4th Transportation Truck Battalion, and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 22 December 1950 at Fort Eustis, Virginia

Reorganized and redesignated 31 October 1952 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 4th Transportation Battalion

Reorganized and redesignated 20 February 1959 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 4th Transportation Battalion
