4th BATTALION 60th AIR DEFENSE ARTILLERY REGIMENT

Constituted 1 July 1924 in the Regular Army as Battery F, 60th Coast Artillery

Activated 1 April 1929 at Fort Mills, Philippines

Surrendered 6 May 1942 to the Japanese *14th Army* on Corregidor Island, Philippines

Inactivated 2 April 1946 at Fort Mills, Philippines

Absorbed 1 August 1946 by Battery B, 60th Antiaircraft Artillery Automatic Weapons Battalion (Battery B, 60th Coast Artillery, redesignated 1 August 1946 as Battery B, 60th Antiaircraft Artillery Automatic Weapons Battalion, and activated at Fort Bliss, Texas; redesignated 7 December 1949 as Battery B, 60th Antiaircraft Artillery Automatic Weapons Battalion, Mobile; redesignated 27 July 1950 as Battery B, 60th Antiaircraft Artillery Battalion; inactivated 17 June 1957 at Southampton, England)

Former Battery F, 60th Coast Artillery, reconstituted 12 August 1958 in the Regular Army and redesignated as Headquarters and Headquarters Battery, 4th Missile Battalion, 60th Artillery (organic elements concurrently constituted)

Battalion activated 1 September 1958 at Midway, Washington

Inactivated 15 December 1961 at Richmond, Washington

Redesignated 25 April 1966 as the 4th Battalion, 60th Artillery

Activated 25 June 1966 at Fort Bliss, Texas

Redesignated 1 September 1971 as the 4th Battalion, 60th Air Defense Artillery

Inactivated 31 July 1972 at Fort Lewis, Washington

Redesignated 1 October 2005 as the 4th Battalion, 60th Air Defense Artillery Regiment


