Activated 1 November 1955 at New York, New York

Inactivated 1 March 1963 at New York, New York

Activated 31 January 1968 at Syracuse, New York

Reorganized and redesignated 15 March 1972 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 359th Signal Group

Reorganized and redesignated 16 September 1987 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 359th Signal Brigade


