## *Lineage and Honors*

### **HEADQUARTERS AND HEADQUARTERS DETACHMENT 402d QUARtermaster BATTALION**

Constituted 6 March 1945 in the Army of the United States as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 402d Quartermaster Service Battalion

Activated 27 March 1945 in England

Inactivated 25 February 1946 in England

Redesignated 16 April 1947 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 402d Quartermaster Battalion, and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 26 April 1947 at Jackson, Mississippi

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Ordered into active military service 11 September 1950 at Jackson, Mississippi; released from active military service 25 April 1955 and reverted to reserve status

Location changed 26 April 1955 to Brookhaven, Mississippi

Inactivated 25 June 1959 at Brookhaven, Mississippi

Activated 15 January 1963 at Jackson, Mississippi

Inactivated 31 January 1968 at Jackson, Mississippi

Activated 16 May 1980 at Farrell, Pennsylvania

Location changed 16 September 1995 to New Castle, Pennsylvania


