HEADQUARTERS AND HEADQUARTERS DETACHMENT 387th REPLACEMENT BATTALION

Constituted 25 July 1942 in the Army of the United States as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 15th Replacement Battalion

Activated 15 August 1942 at Fort Lewis, Washington

Inactivated 15 December 1946 in Japan

Redesignated 28 October 1947 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 387th Replacement Battalion, and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 7 November 1947 at New York, New York

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Inactivated 31 July 1950 at New York, New York

Redesignated 1 March 1974 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 387th Personnel and Administration Battalion, and activated at Wichita, Kansas

Reorganized and redesignated 16 September 1990 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 387th Replacement Battalion

Ordered into active military service 22 January 1991 at Wichita, Kansas; released 15 May 1991 from active military service and reverted to reserve status
