Constituted 3 January 1944 in the Army of the United States as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 52d Quartermaster Base Depot

Activated 10 January 1944 at Camp Lee, Virginia

Inactivated 25 June 1946 in Belgium

Redesignated 14 April 1947 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 451st Quartermaster Base Depot, and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 24 April 1947 at Indianapolis, Indiana

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Reorganized and redesignated 10 April 1953 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 451st Quartermaster Depot

Reorganized and redesignated 31 January 1968 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 451st Field Depot

Inactivated 10 August 1984 at Indianapolis, Indiana

Converted and redesignated 10 February 2009 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 451st Sustainment Command

Activated 16 September 2011 at Wichita, Kansas
