Organized and Federally recognized 1 January 1979 in the Indiana Army National Guard at Indianapolis as the Command and Control Headquarters, Indiana Army National Guard, a Table of Distribution and Allowances unit

Reorganized and redesignated 1 May 1984 as Detachment 1 (Military Academy) [hereafter separate lineage], and Detachment 2 (Troop Command), State Area Command, Indiana Army National Guard, and location changed to Edinburg.

Redesignated 1 July 1994 as 81st Troop Command, Headquarters State Area Command, Indiana Army National Guard

Converted and redesignated 1 September 2002, as the Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 219th Support Group

Ordered into active Federal Service 7 January 2006 at Camp Atterbury; released from active Federal Service 16 March 2007 and reverted to state control

Converted and redesignated 1 September 2008 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 219th Battlefield Surveillance Brigade

Ordered into active Federal Service 20 March 2011 at Camp Atterbury

Location changed 1 November 2011 to Franklin

Released from active Federal Service 6 January 2012 and reverted to state control

Converted and redesignated 1 September 2016 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 219th Engineer Brigade

Consolidated 1 May 2019 with the 1213th Engineer Detachment (organized 1 September 2011) and consolidated unit designated Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 219th Engineer Brigade
