HEADQUARTERS AND HEADQUARTERS DETACHMENT 423d QUARtermaster BATTALION

Constituted 29 July 1944 in the Army of the United States as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 500th Quartermaster Battalion, and activated in England

Reorganized and redesignated 14 June 1946 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 500th Quartermaster Battalion, Mobile

Converted and redesignated 1 August 1946 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 500th Transportation Corps Truck Battalion

Converted and redesignated 1 February 1947 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 500th Quartermaster Battalion

Inactivated 20 June 1948 in Belgium

Redesignated 28 September 1948 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 423d Quartermaster Battalion, and allotted to the Organized Reserve Corps

Activated 7 October 1948 at Roswell, New Mexico

Inactivated 10 October 1950 at Roswell, New Mexico

(Organized Reserve Corps redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Redesignated 15 January 1975 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 423d Supply and Service Battalion, and activated at Albuquerque, New Mexico

Inactivated 16 April 1980 at Albuquerque, New Mexico

HEADQUARTERS AND HEADQUARTERS DETACHMENT 423d QUARTERMASTER BATTALION

Redesignated 26 November 1991 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 423d Support Battalion

Activated 16 September 1995 at Warren, Ohio

Reorganized and redesignated 16 September 2000 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 423d Quartermaster Battalion

Ordered into active military service 15 March 2003 at Warren, Ohio; released from active military service 19 June 2003 and reverted to reserve status


