Constituted 1 September 1943 in the Army of the United States as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 224th Ordnance Base Group

Activated 15 October 1943 at Texarkana, Texas

Redesignated 3 January 1945 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 224th Ordnance Base Depot

Inactivated 29 May 1946 at Aberdeen Proving Ground, Maryland

Redesignated 24 December 1946 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 309th Ordnance Base Depot and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 2 January 1947 at Baltimore, Maryland

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Reorganized and redesignated 4 March 1950 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 309th Ordnance Base Depot

Reorganized and redesignated 31 August 1950 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 326th Ordnance Group

Reorganized and redesignated 27 July 1959 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 326th Ordnance Group

Inactivated 31 January 1968 at Baltimore, Maryland

Redesignated 1 March 1974 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 326th Support Group and activated at Kansas City, Kansas

HEADQUARTERS AND HEADQUARTERS COMPANY 326th SUPPORT GROUP

Ordered into active military service 13 September 2004 at Kansas City, Kansas; released from active military service 11 March 2006 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 27 October 2008 at Kansas City, Kansas


