### **HEADQUARTERS 94th TRAINING DIVISION**

Constituted 24 June 1921 in the Organized Reserves as Headquarters, 94th Division

Organized in November 1921 at Boston, Massachusetts

Redesignated 12 February 1942 as Division Headquarters, 94th Division

Ordered into active military service 15 September 1942 and reorganized at Fort Custer, Michigan, as Headquarters, 94th Infantry Division

Inactivated 7 February 1946 at Camp Kilmer, New Jersey

Activated 1 November 1946 at Boston, Massachusetts

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Reorganized and redesignated 1 May 1959 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 94th Infantry Division

Reorganized and redesignated 1 March 1963 as Headquarters Company, 94th Operational Headquarters

Redesignated 1 June 1963 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 94th Command Headquarters

Inactivated 22 December 1965 at Boston, Massachusetts

Redesignated 23 June 1982 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 94th Infantry Division
