HEADQUARTERS 91st DIVISION (TRAINING SUPPORT) (WILD WEST DIVISION)

Constituted 5 August 1917 in the National Army as Headquarters, 91st Division

Organized 26 August 1917 at Camp Lewis, Washington

Demobilized 13 May 1919 at the Presidio of San Francisco, California

Reconstituted 24 June 1921 in the Organized Reserves as Headquarters, 91st Division

Organized 7 October 1921 at San Francisco, California

Redesignated 6 April 1942 as Division Headquarters, 91st Division

Ordered into active military service 15 May 1942 and reorganized at Camp White, Oregon; concurrently redesignated as Headquarters, 91st Infantry Division

Inactivated 1 December 1945 at Camp Rucker, Alabama

Activated 31 December 1946 at San Francisco, California

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Reorganized and redesignated 1 May 1959 as Headquarters, 91st Division (Training)

Location changed 1 October 1975 to Sausalito, California

Reorganized and redesignated 1 October 1993 as Headquarters, 91st Division (Exercise)

Reorganized and redesignated 17 October 1999 as Headquarters, 91st Division (Training Support)
