## HEADQUARTERS AND HEADQUARTERS COMPANY 106th SIGNAL BRIGADE

Constituted 12 February 1943 in the Army of the United States as the 932d Signal Battalion

Activated 15 February 1943 at Birmingham, Alabama

Reorganized and redesignated 20 April 1944 as the 932d Signal Battalion, Separate, Tactical Air Command

Inactivated 13 October 1945 at Camp Kilmer, New Jersey (organic elements concurrently disbanded)

Headquarters, 932d Signal Battlion, Separate, Tactical Air Command, redesignated 24 April 1963 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 106th Signal Group, and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 12 August 1963 in France

Inactivated 13 November 1967 in Germany

Redesignated 16 October 1991 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 106th Signal Brigade, and activated in Panama
