Constituted 23 February 1943 in the Army of the United States as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 3d Battalion, 519th Quartermaster Truck Regiment

Activated 26 April 1943 at Camp Joseph T. Robinson, Arkansas

Reorganized and redesignated 20 December 1943 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 180th Quartermaster Battalion, Mobile

Inactivated 12 December 1945 at Camp Kilmer, New Jersey

Converted and redesignated 1 August 1946 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 180th Transportation Corps Truck Battalion

Redesignated 7 December 1966 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 180th Transportation Battalion, and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 23 January 1967 at Fort Hood, Texas
