### **HEADQUARTERS AND HEADQUARTERS DETACHMENT 302d TRANSPORTATION BATTALION**

Constituted 28 May 1943 in the Army of the United States as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 52d Quartermaster Truck Battalion

Activated 22 June 1943 in Algeria

Reorganized and redesignated 22 May 1944 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 52d Quartermaster Battalion, Mobile

Converted and redesignated 1 August 1946 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 52d Transportation Corps Truck Battalion

Inactivated 31 January 1947 in Italy

Redesignated 7 July 1948 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 302d Transportation Truck Battalion, and allotted to the Organized Reserve Corps

Activated 14 July 1948 at Cleveland, Ohio

Reorganized and redesignated 16 September 1949 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 302d Transportation Truck Battalion

Inactivated 10 May 1952 at Cleveland, Ohio

(Organized Reserve Corps redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Redesignated 31 March 1959 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 302d Transportation Battalion

Activated 24 April 1959 at Cleveland, Ohio

Inactivated 31 December 1965 at Cleveland, Ohio

Activated 1 September 1979 at Glenview, Illinois

Inactivated 15 September 1988 at Glenview, Illinois

Activated 16 September 2008 at Fort Shafter, Hawaii


