**HEADQUARTERS AND HEADQUARTERS DETACHMENT
232d SUPPORT BATTALION**

Constituted 3 July 1946 in the Illinois National Guard as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 32d Ordnance Battalion

Organized and Federally recognized 31 March 1950 at Springfield

Ordered into active Federal service 19 August 1950 at Springfield

Redesignated 1 December 1950 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 32d Ordnance Ammunition Battalion

(Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 32d Ordnance Battalion [NGUS], organized and Federally recognized 15 December 1952 at Springfield)

Redesignated 20 March 1953 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 32d Ordnance Battalion

Released from active Federal service 26 May 1955 and reverted to state control; Federal recognition concurrently withdrawn from Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 32d Ordnance Battalion (NGUS)

Converted, reorganized, and redesignated 15 December 1967 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 232d Supply and Service Battalion

Reorganized and redesignated 13 April 1984 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 232d Supply and Service Battalion

Reorganized and redesignated 1 September 1994 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 232d Support Battalion

Ordered into active Federal service 31 December 1996 at Springfield; released from active Federal service in 1997 and reverted to state control

Ordered into active Federal service 7 December 2003 at Springfield; released from active Federal service 3 June 2005 and reverted to state control
