1 st BATTALION, 29th INFANTRY REGIMENT (THE PIONEERS)

Constituted 2 February 1901 in the Regular Army as Company A, 29th Infantry

Organized 5 March 1901 at Fort Sheridan, Illinois

(29th Infantry assigned 29 July 1918 to the 17th Division; relieved 10 February 1919 from assignment to the 17th Division; assigned 1 October 1933 to the 4th Division; relieved 16 October 1939 from assignment to the 4th Division; assigned 1 June 1940 to the 4th Division; relieved 10 October 1941 from assignment to the 4th Division)

Inactivated 31 October 1946 in Germany

Activated 1 May 1949 on Okinawa

(29th Infantry assigned 2 December 1954 to the 23d Infantry Division; relieved 1 March 1956 from assignment to the 23d Infantry Division)

Reorganized and redesignated 25 May 1957 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 1st Battle Group, 29th Infantry (organic elements concurrently constituted and activated)

Assigned 25 July 1958 to the 1st Infantry Brigade

Relieved 20 September 1962 from assignment to the 1st Infantry Brigade

Inactivated 24 September 1962 at Fort Benning, Georgia

Redesignated 4 January 1963 as the 1st Battalion, 29th Infantry, and assigned to the 197th Infantry Brigade

1st BATTALION, 29th INFANTRY REGIMENT (THE PIONEERS)

Activated 1 February 1963 at Fort Benning, Georgia

Relieved 21 March 1973 from assignment to the 197th Infantry Brigade

Headquarters transferred 11 September 1987 to the United States Army Training and Doctrine Command and reorganized at Fort Benning, Georgia

Battalion redesignated 1 October 2005 as the 1st Battalion, 29th Infantry Regiment
