HEADQUARTERS AND HEADQUARTERS COMPANY 308th CIVIL AFFAIRS BRIGADE

Constituted 1 March 1949 in the Organized Reserve Corps as the 308th Military Government Group

Activated 24 March 1949 at Chicago, Illinois

Ordered into active military service 11 September 1950 at Chicago, Illinois

(Organized Reserve Corps redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Released from active military service 9 February 1955 and reverted to reserve status

Reorganized and redesignated 3 August 1956 as the 308th Civil Affairs and Military Government Group

Location changed 1 June 1957 to Evanston, Illinois

Redesignated 26 October 1959 as the 308th Civil Affairs Group

Location changed 1 March 1963 to Chicago, Illinois; on 1 September 1975 to Homewood, Illinois

Reorganized and redesignated 16 September 1992 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 308th Civil Affairs Brigade

(Elements ordered into active military service for the Global War on Terrorism)
