Activated 14 February 1948 at Los Angeles, California

Inactivated 30 November 1950 at Los Angeles, California

Redesignated 24 July 1965 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 319th Transportation Group

Activated 17 August 1964 at San Francisco, California
