### **HEADQUARTERS AND HEADQUARTERS COMPANY 2d ENGINEER BRIGADE**

Constituted 12 June 1942 in the Army of the United States as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 2d Engineer Amphibian Brigade

Activated 20 June 1942 at Camp Edwards, Massachusetts

Redesignated 10 May 1943 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 2d Engineer Special Brigade

Redesignated 26 June 1952 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 2d Amphibious Support Brigade, and allotted to the Regular Army

Inactivated 24 June 1955 in Japan

Redesignated 18 October 1956 as Command Headquarters, 2d Engineer Amphibious Support Command

Activated 13 November 1956 at Fort Belvoir, Virginia

Inactivated 25 August 1965 at Fort Story, Virginia

Redesignated 10 September 2009 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 2d Engineer Brigade

Activated 16 September 2011 at Fort Richardson, Alaska


