HEADQUARTERS AND HEADQUARTERS DETACHMENT 814TH TRANSPORTATION BATTALION

Constituted 31 October 1942 in the Army of the United States as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 2d Battalion, 517th Quartermaster Truck Regiment

Activated 7 December 1942 at Camp Van Dorn, Mississippi

Reorganized and redesignated 15 December 1943 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 93d Quartermaster Battalion, Mobile

Inactivated 3 November 1945 at Camp Kilmer, New Jersey

Converted and redesignated 1 August 1946 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 93d Transportation Corps Truck Battalion

Redesignated 23 September 1948 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 814th Transportation Truck Battalion, and allotted to the Organized Reserve Corps

Activated 2 October 1948 at Athens, Georgia

Reorganized and redesignated 1 February 1950 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 814th Transportation Truck Battalion

Inactivated 30 June 1952 at Athens, Georgia

(Organized Reserve Corps redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Redesignated 17 April 1959 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 814th Transportation Battalion

HEADQUARTERS AND HEADQUARTERS DETACHMENT 814TH TRANSPORTATION BATTALION

Activated 1 June 1959 at Albemarle, North Carolina

Ordered into active military service 15 October 1961 at Albemarle, North Carolina; released from active military service 11 August 1962 and reverted to reserve status

Location changed 1 March 1964 to Miami, Florida

Inactivated 31 December 1965 at Miami, Florida

Activated 16 September 2015 at Boise, Idaho
