Inactivated 30 November 1945 at Camp Carson, Colorado

Redesignated 18 June 1948 as Headquarters Company, 10th Infantry Division

Allotted 25 June 1948 to the Regular Army

Activated 1 July 1948 at Fort Riley, Kansas

Inactivated 14 June 1958 at Fort Benning, Georgia

Redesignated 1 April 1986 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 1st Brigade, 10th Mountain Division, and activated at Fort Drum, New York

Headquarters Company, 1st Brigade, 10th Mountain Division, reorganized and redesignated 16 September 2004 as Special Troops Battalion, 1st Brigade Combat Team, 10th Mountain Division (Headquarters, 1st Brigade, 10th Mountain Division – hereafter separate lineage)
