Redesignated 23 May 1947 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 310th Hospital Center, and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 25 June 1947 at Seattle, Washington

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Redesignated 1 September 1949 as Headquarters, 310th Hospital Center

Inactivated 15 September 1950 at Seattle, Washington

Redesignated 11 May 1954 as the 310th Convalescent Center

Activated 1 June 1954 at San Diego, California

Inactivated 1 July 1959 at San Diego, California
