Constituted 4 July 1944 in the Army of the United States as the 3d Medical Composite Detachment

Activated 15 August 1944 in New Guinea

Reorganized and redesignated 1 May 1945 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 3d Medical Concentration Center

Inactivated 25 January 1946 in the Philippines

Redesignated 22 January 1947 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 410th Concentration Center, and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 30 January 1947 at Baton Rouge, Louisiana

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Redesignated 29 August 1949 as Headquarters, 410th Medical Concentration Center

Inactivated 6 October 1950 at Baton Rouge, Louisiana

Redesignated 16 September 1995 as the 410th Medical Center and activated at Upper Marlboro, Maryland

Inactivated 15 April 2000 at Upper Marlboro, Maryland

Redesignated 17 April 2015 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 410th Hospital Center

Activated 16 September 2017 at Fort George G. Meade, Maryland
