**HEADQUARTERS AND HEADQUARTERS DETACHMENT
360th REPLACEMENT BATTALION**

Constituted 8 January 1944 in the Army of the United States as the 360th Replacement Company

Activated 15 January 1944 at Camp Croft, South Carolina

Inactivated 28 June 1946 in Germany

Redesignated 10 April 1947 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 360th Replacement Battalion, and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 24 April 1947 at Newark, New Jersey

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Inactivated 12 July 1950 at Newark, New Jersey

Redesignated 16 October 1984 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 360th Personnel and Administration Battalion, and activated at Florence, South Carolina

Location changed 15 April 1988 to Myrtle Beach, South Carolina

Reorganized and redesignated 16 September 1990 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 360th Replacement Battalion

HEADQUARTERS AND HEADQUARTERS DETACHMENT 360th REPLACEMENT BATTALION

Ordered into active military service 27 December 1990 at Myrtle Beach, South Carolina; released from active military service 31 May 1991 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 14 August 1997 at Myrtle Beach, South Carolina; later released from active military service and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 13 January 2004 at Myrtle Beach, South Carolina; released from active military service 11 January 2006 and reverted to reserve status
