HEADQUARTERS AND HEADQUARTERS DETACHMENT 380th REPLACEMENT BATTALION

Constituted 21 January 1944 in the Army of the United States as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 92d Replacement Battalion

Activated 3 February 1944 in Northern Ireland

Inactivated 17 September 1945 in France

Redesignated 13 June 1947 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 380th Replacement Battalion, and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 21 June 1947 at Springfield, Massachusetts

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Location changed 11 October 1949 to Norfolk, Connecticut

Inactivated 30 June 1950 at Norfolk, Connecticut

Redesignated 16 May 1983 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 380th Personnel and Administration Battalion

Activated 16 March 1985 at Fort Lawton, Washington

HEADQUARTERS AND HEADQUARTERS DETACHMENT 380th REPLACEMENT BATTALION

Location changed 14 May 1988 to Redmond, Washington; on 12 September 1993 to Bothell, Washington

Reorganized and redesignated 16 September 1990 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 380th Replacement Battalion

Ordered into active military service 26 February 2003 at Bothell, Washington; released from active military service 25 February 2004 and reverted to reserve status
