Inactivated 15 September 1996 at Fort Hood, Texas

Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 2d Battalion, 158th Aviation, redesignated 16 October 1997 as Company B, 158th Aviation, and activated at Fort Hood, Texas

Redesignated 1 October 2005 as Company B, 158th Aviation Regiment

Inactivated 15 January 2008 at Fort Hood, Texas

Redesignated 17 October 2011 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 2d Battalion, 158th Aviation Regiment, and activated at Joint Base Lewis-McChord, Washington (organic elements concurrently activated)
