



Congressman Drewry recommends the name Pryor for the new camp near Blackstone, Va. This name had already been recommended and is among the names being considered in G-3/43440 dated Jan. 5, 1942, which has been sent to the OCS. In a reply to Dr. Freeman, newspaper editor of Richmond, the Chief of Staff indicated that in view of Dr. Freeman's opposition to the name Pryor it would probably not be chosen. Letter from Congressman Drewry has already been acknowledged by TAG.
